THE PORT OF TILBURY (EXPANSION) ORDER 2019

ARTICLE 12

NOTICE OF STOPPING UP OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY

BACKGROUND

- (1) The above-named order ("**the Order**") was made by the Secretary of State for Transport under the Planning Act 2008 on 20th March 2019.
- (2) Article 12 of the Order authorises Port of Tilbury London Limited ("**the Undertaker**") to divert and extinguish public rights of way, subject to notice being given pursuant to article 12(5) of the Order.

THE UNDERTAKER NOW GIVES NOTICE THAT:-

1. a length of public footpath 144, from a point 162 metres south of its junction with the existing highway known as the Beeches (Grid reference TQ646760) and then in a southerly then easterly then southerly direction, to a point 300 metres north-east of the junction between Footpath 144 and Fort Road (Grid reference TQ647756), and as shown by the YELLOW line on the plan accompanying this notice, is to be stopped up;
2. the stopping up referred to in paragraph 1 will take place on 2nd April 2019; and
3. no substitute public right of way is to be provided.
